<b>B. NEW ZEALAND</b>	<b>SAUVIGNON BLANC, Cloudy Bay, 2015</b> This wine needs little introduction! As sought after today as it was on its introduction in the mid 80's, Cloudy Bay continues to make iconic, characterful wines that are the epitome of Marlborough Sauvignon. <b>D. ARGENTINA</b>	<b>FELINO MALBEC, Cobos, 2015</b> Paul Hobbs is justifiably famous for producing some of the finest wines in the U.S and South America. His Felino Malbec is youthful, succulent and juicy with savoury, earthy tones and a delicious mineral, fruit-packed finish.	<b>31.00</b>
<b>E. CALIFORNIA</b>	<b>ZINFANDEL, Eberle Steinbeck &amp; Wine Bush Vineyards, 2013</b> Eberle Zinfandel displays classic aromatics reminiscent of sweet briar fruit, flavours of ripe blackberry and raspberry accented by hints of earth, pepper and sweet oak.	<b>46.00</b>
<b>G. ITALY</b>	<b>AMARONE DELLA VALPOLICELLA, DOCG, Ilatium Morini, 2011</b> Amarone is quite simply liquid velvet. Very intense and ample, with nuances of ripe red fruits and kirsch, spicy notes such as vanilla, nutmeg, black pepper and cocoa. The mouth is very warm, soft and fresh, with delicate oak and tannin. <b>42. ITALY</b>	<b>MONTEPULCIANO D'ABRUZZO, Zero, DOC, Collefrisio, 2014</b> Rich, savoury, complex version of that old Italian classic. Ample dark, herby, black fruit with hints of spice.	<b>21.50</b>
<b>45. ITALY</b>	<b>CHIANTI RISERVA DOCG, Baccio, Le Chiantigiane, 2011</b> Brambles, morello cherries and ripe fruits are balanced with soft tannins and acidity. A real classic!	<b>25.50</b>

<b>32. CHILE</b>	<b>MERLOT, Armador, Odfjell, 2015</b> Chile's favourite grape is coaxed into making a fleshy, ripe, plummy red with tasty licks of chocolate and coffee.	<b>24.50</b>

AUSTRALIA</b>	<b>CABERNET SHIRAZ, 'The Musician', Majella, 2013</b> Using the same fabulous fruit that goes into the much revered Majella Cabernet and Shiraz, Musician is a younger, more fruit-driven version using a little less new oak. Blackcurrant, eucalyptus and mint on the nose followed by a huge whack of juicy, savoury fruit on the palate. This is pure Coonawarra at a bargain price – awesome!	<b>30.00</b>
<b>36. ARGENTINA</b>	<b>BONARDA, Serie A, Familia Zuccardi, 2015</b> Packed with rich red and black fruit, savoury cherry and chocolate character and silky tannins.	<b>29.50</b>
<b>46. SPAIN</b>	<b>LU&amp;BE, Dominio Cair, DO Ribera del Duero, 2014</b> Deep solid ruby garnet with an intense nose and balanced fruit and oak with nuances of chocolate, leather and cedar. A meaty palate with very sweet tannins and a long, lingering finish.	<b>30.00</b>
<b>35. SPAIN</b>	<b>RIOJA RESERVA, Luis Canas, 2011</b> Deep cherry red, clean and bright. Good aromatic intensity with notes of ripe red fruits over a base of elegant balsamic.
